The mosque has the tombs of Sheikhs Ali Abi Shibak and Yahya al-Ansari, as well as the tombs of the royal family, where Khedive Ismail, his mother Khushiyar Hanim, the founder of the mosque, his wives and children, Sultan Hussein Kamel and his wife, King Fuad I, and King Farouk I are buried.

the Giza Pyramids: which are monumental tombs constructed by three different Pharaohs of the Old Kingdom from 2686 to 2181 BCE. Pyramids were symbols of a Pharaoh's power and affirmed their status as a divine ruler.

AL-Rifai Mosque: It is one of the oldest mosques in Egypt as well as the whole of Africa surviving in its full original form, and is the largest mosque in Cairo in terms of land area.

Sultan Hassan Mosque: The Madrasa of Sultan Hasan was constructed to include schools for all four of the Sunni doctrines of thought: Shafi'i, Hanbali, Hanafi, and Maliki. It used to house more than four hundred students.
