Itinerary

Day 1: Arrival in Egypt

Our professional tour guide will assist you with all of your customs processes once you arrive at [Cairo International Airport](#). After that, a luxurious private van will transport you to your accommodation. A welcoming drink will be served to you when you arrive. To make sure you enjoy every second of your sumptuous 5-day excursions of Cairo and Luxor, they will be modified.

Day 2: Giza Pyramids and the Egyptian Museum, Optional Cairo Nile Cruise Dinner

You will meet our representative after breakfast, and they will drive us to the hotel so that we may start our travel to Cairo. The archeological complex known for its three large pyramids (Cheops, Chephren, and Mycerinus) and the Great Sphinx will be the first stop on our tour of [the Giza Pyramids](#). Before continuing our tour of [the Egyptian Museum](#), we will have lunch. In addition to the incredible archeological discoveries, [King Tutankhamun's](#) priceless treasure and a rare, 7 cm-tall ivory statue of the legendary King Cheops are on display. A granite figure of Queen Hatshepsut is also on display, together with 120,000 other artifacts dating from the Paleolithic to the Greco-Roman periods of ancient Egypt.

After your day trips in Cairo are completed, you will have the opportunity to enjoy a pleasant dinner on a Nile cruise while watching the Tanura oriental dance show.

Day 3: Fly to Luxor, West Bank Tours

Before helping you with the check-out process, our consultant will eat breakfast at the hotel with you. Afterward, you'll make a transport to the Cairo airport based on when your flight to Luxor is scheduled to leave. [The Valley of the Kings](#) is a necropolis that served as a burial place for the kings and rulers of ancient Egypt during the New Kingdom. When you arrive at [Luxor airport](#), you will be greeted and given assistance to begin your Luxor West Bank tours. Here, amid the silence, desert, and sky, you will have a delightful experience by visiting three of the royal tombs. You will then go with your Luxor tours to the Temple of Hatshepsut, which her devoted architect Senmout erected, and [the Colossi of Memnon](#), where our guide will explain. You can imagine how large these statues were when they were within the Amenhotep III Temple. Last but not least, you'll eat lunch during an outing at a reputable establishment. You will travel to your Luxor hotel after lunch and spend the night there.

Day 4: Luxor East Bank Tours

You will visit [the Karnak Temple](#), a collection of temples, holy lakes, obelisks, chapels, and avenues, after breakfast. It is believed that because of its magnificence, it served as the primary place of religious worship in the new kingdom of ancient Egypt. After that, you'll eat lunch in a restaurant before continuing your Luxor sightseeing tours. [The Luxor Temple](#), which is still open today, is where you'll travel next. [Amun](#) was the father of the Egyptian gods and was honored there. Amenhotep III, who ruled during the eighteenth dynasty, constructed this structure, which is situated on the east bank of the Nile. Ramses II, a well-known king, finished it. A sphinx-lined boulevard was built between the Temple of Karnak's building and the same period. The flight back to Cairo will thereafter depart from Luxor Airport. You will be met by our agent at Cairo Airport upon your arrival, and you will be taken to the hotel for the night.

Day 5: Final Departure

You will meet our tour guide at the hotel after breakfast, and you will then be taken in an air-conditioned vehicle to the airport to catch your flight back home.
